When students enroll in band, choir, or any sport, keep in mind that all requirements expected of regularly enrolled students apply to the non-enrolled student as well. When appointments are made for off-campus activities, such as a concert at a church, or an away game, the student should expect to meet deadlines and time requirements.

Team/group pictures of each activity and sport are important to us. They are published in the yearbook as an historical record and students are again expected to meet deadlines and time requirements.
